Please complete the form with as much information as possible. In addition to the form, you should provide an OS Pathfinder map (4cm to 1km) of the launch site and surrounding areas. On this map you should identify the launch area, down range area, perimeter of the site and any hazards identified.

Site Details

Site Name/Location: The name of your site e.g. "Birtlebog Farm, Newton, NG34 1AP, 9 miles north of Sleaford on the A17"

OS Grid Reference: Ordinance Survey Grid reference e.g. "Cranwell N5301.80 W0028.90"

Maximum Motor Class: Governed by the site dimensions see Site dimensions table in the UKRA Safety code e.g. "normally up to L class, M class if wind is NNW"

Controlled Airspace and height restrictions: These can be obtained for your site from Air Navigation Charts. Contact UKRA if you require assistance.

Airports and Airfields: The site should not be within 5 miles of any active airport or airfield. Include the nearest airfields on the form.

Hazards: Identify any potential hazards whether manmade or natural which fall within or are close to the boundaries of the launch site. These should be clearly numbered and marked on the OS map. Are there other Aerial activities carried out close by e.g. gliding, microlites,

Facilities: Note any facilities such as toilets, pubs, shops on or near the launch site.

Useful contacts: Make a note of useful numbers particularly the Landowner and any utility companies so they can be contacted quickly. In the event of injury, fire, theft or other serious events always use the 999 Emergency service.

Once you have completed the form return it with the site map to UKRA at

Regularly review the site information and inform UKRA of any changes. You should always have a copy of this document with you when you fly.
